- Longest concrete viaduct in England over Woodlesford (2.2km long, 36metres high).
- Two 1.9km tunnels under Woodlesford.
- Falling house and property prices.
- 18 trains per hour (one every 3 minutes 5am to midnight).
- The Aire Valley decimated, greenbelt land and wildlife destroyed including; Water Haigh Woodland Park, fishing lakes, footpaths, birds (inc. owls), deer, otters, water voles and bats.
